7 (1) on the number of firearm transactions with 8 respect to which the national instant criminal back-9 ground check system established under the Brady 10 Handgun Violence Prevention Act has determined 11 that receipt of a firearm by the prospective firearm 12 transferee would violate Federal or State law, and 13 which have been referred to the Bureau of Alcohol, 14 Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives for investigation;

(2) on the number of persons prosecuted by a
United States attorney for an alleged violation of
Federal law in connection with a transaction referred to in paragraph (1); and
