## Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 118–10 Offered by Ms. Bush of Missouri

At the end of subtitle C of title XVIII, add the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_. REPORT ON STATUS OF POLITICAL PRISONERS 2 WORLDWIDE.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 365 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
5 in consultation with the Director of Intelligence, shall sub6 mit to the appropriate congressional committees a report
7 on the number and status of political prisoners worldwide.
8 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-

9 quired by subsection (a)—

(1) shall include a detailed assessment of how 10 11 many individuals are detained or imprisoned, or the 12 victim of an enforced disappearance worldwide, in-13 cluding individuals who are human rights defenders 14 or are detained, imprisoned, or otherwise physically 15 restricted, because of their political, religious, other 16 conscientiously-held beliefs, their identity, or their 17 actual or perceived participation in protests; and

18 (2) shall include an assessment of the number19 of individuals detained, imprisoned, or forcibly dis-

appeared for the reasons described in paragraph (1)
 in each country.

3 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
4 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but portions of
5 the report may contain a classified annex, so long as such
6 annex is provided separately from the unclassified report.

7 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
8 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate con9 gressional committees" means—

10 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
11 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of
12 House of Representatives; and

13 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and14 the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.
