At the end of subtitle C of title XVII, insert the following:

1 SEC. 17____. GRANT PROGRAMS RELATING TO PROTECTING 2 NATIONAL SECURITY BY INVESTING IN SAFE 3 AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR ALL.

4 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-5 gress that ending domestic homelessness and providing 6 safe and affordable housing for all is essential to national 7 security and the ability of the to respond to major global 8 challenges.

9 (b) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the General Fund of the Treasury a fund, to be administered 10 11 by the Secretary of Defense, to be used to protect the future national security of the United States by investing 12 in the housing system of the United States. The Secretary 13 14 shall award the total amount authorized to be appro-15 priated to the fund in grants to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for the purposes of making 16 available additional funding for the following programs 17 18 and funds:

9	(c) Offset.—The total amount authorized to be ap-
10	propriated for the Department of Defense for fiscal year
11	2025 by this Act (other than for the Fund established in
12	subsection (a), military personnel, and the Defense Health
13	Program) is hereby reduced by \$50,000,000,000.
14	(d) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
15	authorized to be appropriated to the fund established
16	under subsection (b) \$50,000,000,000 for fiscal year
17	2025.
18	(e) ALLOCATION.—The reduction made by subsection
19	(c) shall—
20	(1) apply on a pro rata basis among the ac-
21	counts and funds for which accounts are authorized
22	to be appropriated by this Act (other than military
23	personnel and the Defense Health Program);

(2) be applied on a pro rata basis across each
 program, project, and activity funded by the account
 or fund concerned; and

4 (3) be transferred to the fund established under5 subsection (b).
