OFFERED BY MRS. BUSTOS OF ILLINOIS

Page 137, line 21, strike “and” at the end.

Page 137, line 25, strike the period at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 137, after line 25, insert the following:

1 (D) in clause (xi), by striking “and” at the
2 end;

3 (E) in clause (xii), by striking the period
4 and inserting “; and”; and

5 (F) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(xiii) training programs (including
7 activities that prepare individuals for occu-
8 pations in the technology sector) for indi-
9 viduals who are, or are likely to become,
10 dislocated workers as a result of automa-
11 tion, which includes a device, process, or
12 system that functions without continuous
13 input from an operator, including—

14 “(I) advanced technologies, such
15 as—

1 “(aa) data collection, classi-
2 fication processing, and analytics;
3 and
4 “(bb) 3–D printing, digital
5 design and simulation, and dig-
6 ital manufacturing;
7 “(II) robotics, including collabo-
8 rative robotics, and worker augmenta-
9 tion technology;
10 “(III) autonomous vehicle tech-
11 nology; or
12 “(IV) autonomous machinery
13 technology.”.

Page 177, after line 5, insert the following:

14 (a) AUTOMATION TECHNOLOGY.—Section
15 170(b)(1)(A) (29 U.S.C. 3225(b)(1)(A)) is amended by
16 inserting “advances in automation technology (as de-
17 scribed in section 134(d)(1)(A)(xiii)),” before “plant clo-
18 sures,”.

Page 177, line 6, strike “Section 170(e)(1)(B)” and
insert the following:

19 (b) NATIONAL OR REGIONAL INTERMEDIARIES.—
20 Section 170(c)(1)(B)

Page 177, after line 10, insert the following:

1 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
2 170 (29 U.S.C. 3225) is further amended by adding at
3 the end the following:

4 “(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In ad-
5 dition to any funds reserved under section 132(a)(2)(A)
6 to carry out this section, there are authorized to be appro-
7 priated to carry out this section \$40,000,000 for each of
8 fiscal years 2023 through 2027.”.
