Page 620, after line 8 insert the following:

1 SEC. 802. FINDING.

2 The Congress finds that the Elementary and Sec-3 ondary Education Act of 1965 reaffirmed the Supreme 4 Court's decision in Brown v. Board of Education that 5 every child has the right to an equal educational oppor-6 tunity. Thanks to some of the reforms instituted as part 7 of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, we now have better information on how vulnerable students are per-8 9 forming. On the National Assessment of Educational Progress - our nation's longest standing measure for stu-10 11 dent achievement - economically disadvantaged and stu-12 dents of color have actually improved faster than at any 13 other time since 1980. We must continue the historic Fed-14 eral role in elementary and secondary education to support 15 schools and districts with high concentrations of poverty.
