**A BILL**

To authorize the President to impose visa sanctions with respect to individuals the President determines are Russian nationals involved in combat operations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO IMPOSE VISA SANCTIONS.**

4 (a) DETERMINATION.—The President may impose

5 the sanction described in subsection (b) with respect to

6 any individual the President determines, based on credible

7 evidence,

1 (1) is a national of Russia; and

2 (2) has been involved in combat operations of  
3 any sort **【is this only in Ukraine or anywhere?  
4 should it be only combat operations on behalf of Rus-  
5 sia or include nationals of Russia who may have  
6 joined the armies of other countries?】**

7 (b) SANCTION.—The sanction described in this sub-  
8 section is the following:

9 (1) INADMISSIBILITY.—An alien described in  
10 subsection (a) is—

11 (A) inadmissible to the United States;

12 (B) ineligible for a visa or other docu-  
13 mentation to enter the United States; and

14 (C) otherwise ineligible to be admitted or  
15 paroled into the United States or to receive any  
16 other benefit under the Immigration and Na-  
17 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.).

18 (2) REVOCATION OF DOCUMENTS.—The visa or  
19 other entry documentation of an alien described in  
20 subsection (a) shall be revoked, regardless of when  
21 such visa or other entry documentation was issued.  
22 A revocation under this paragraph shall take effect  
23 in accordance with section 221(i) of the Immigration  
24 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1201(i)) and cancel

- 1 any other valid visa or entry documentation that is
- 2 in the alien's possession.
