

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-

OFFERED BY MR. BANKS OF INDIANA

At the end of subtitle E of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5___ . PRELIMINARY INQUIRY ON ARLINGTON NA-**
2 **TIONAL CEMETERY BURIAL.**

3 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

4 (1) The Department of Defense must ensure
5 that only individuals who have served honorably are
6 interred or inurned at Arlington National Cemetery.

7 (2) Recent news reports have alleged that Army
8 Sergeant Jack Edward Dunlap, who was buried at
9 Arlington National Cemetery in 1963, may have
10 been the past subject of an espionage investigation
11 by the National Security Agency, the results of
12 which have not been made public.

13 (b) INQUIRY REQUIRED.—The General Counsel of
14 the Department of the Army shall, pursuant to the terms
15 of section 553.21 of title 32, Code of Federal Regulations,
16 carry out a preliminary inquiry to investigate the Arling-
17 ton National Cemetery burial of Jack Edward Dunlap due

1 to accusations that he supplied the Soviet Union with valu-
2 able intelligence during the Cold War.
