6	"(a) In General.—The Secretary shall prohibit the
7	export or sale of petroleum products drawn down from the
8	Strategic Petroleum Reserve, under any provision of law,

10	"(1) the People's Republic of China;
11	"(2) the Democratic People's Republic of
12	Korea;
13	"(3) the Russian Federation;
14	"(4) the Islamic Republic of Iran;
15	"(5) any other country the government of which
16	is subject to sanctions imposed by the United States;
17	and
18	"(6) any entity owned or controlled by—

1	"(A) a country referred to in any of para-
2	graphs (1) through (5); or
3	"(B) the Chinese Communist Party.
4	"(b) Waiver.—The Secretary may issue a waiver of
5	the prohibition described in subsection (a) if the Secretary
6	certifies that any export or sale authorized pursuant to
7	the waiver is in the national security interests of the
8	United States.
9	"(c) Rule.—Not later than 60 days after the date
10	of enactment of the Servicemember Quality of Life Im-
11	provement and National Defense Authorization Act for
12	Fiscal Year 2025, the Secretary shall issue a rule to carry
13	out this section.".
