## Amendment to S. Con. Res. 3 Offered by \_\_\_\_\_

Add at the end of title IV the following new section (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. STATEMENT OF POLICY.

It is a sense of Congress that stripping away health care coverage for 22 million Americans is harmful towards the betterment of our country and irresponsible to not have an immediate and responsible health care insurance replacement plan. It is further a sense of Congress that this is a bipartisan agreement due to the following statements:
