istered provisional status, naturalization, or any other im-2 migration benefit, upon the request of the Secretary. 3 (c) Consequence of Noncompliance.— 4 (1) First Year.—If any State or local election 5 official is not in compliance with the proof of citizen-6 ship requirements under subsection (a)(1) on or be-7 fore the date that is 1 year after the date of the en-8 actment of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation 9 shall reduce the apportionment calculated under sec-10 tion 104(c) of title 23, United States Code, for the 11 applicable State for the following fiscal year by 10 12 percent. 13 (2) Subsequent Years.—For each subsequent 14 vear in which any State or local election official is 15 not in compliance with the proof of citizenship re-16 quirements under subsection (a)(1), the Secretary of 17 Transportation shall reduce the apportionment cal-18 culated under section 104(c) of title 23, United 19 States Code, for the applicable State for the fol-20 lowing fiscal year by an additional 10 percent.
