In section 2—

- (1) redesignate subsections (d) and (e) as subsections (e) and (f), respectively; and
 - (2) insert after subsection (c) the following:
- 1 (d) PIPELINE SAFETY EQUIPMENT.—No person shall
- 2 be liable under the Comprehensive Environmental Re-
- 3 sponse, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (42)
- 4 U.S.C. 9601 et seq.) for the costs of responding to, or
- 5 damages resulting from, a release to the environment of
- 6 a perfluoroalkyl or polyfluoroalkyl substance designated as
- 7 a hazardous substance under section 102(a) of such Act
- 8 that is related to the manufacture of a seal, hose, o-ring,
- 9 gasket, or other pipeline safety equipment, that is required
- 10 to meet minimum safety standards for pipeline facilities
- 11 under chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code.

Page 9, line 14, strike "For a period" and insert "Except as provided in paragraph (3), for a period".

Page 10, after line 2, insert the following:

"(3) EXEMPTION FOR MANUFACTURE OF PIPELINE SAFETY EQUIPMENT.—This subsection shall
not apply with respect to a notice described in paragraph (1) that is related to the manufacture of a
seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or other pipeline safety
equipment, that is required to meet minimum safety
standards for pipeline facilities under chapter 601 of
title 49, United States Code.".

Section 8(b) is amended by adding at the end the following: "In revising such list, the Administrator shall exclude from any category or subcategory so listed a source whose emissions of such a substance are related to the manufacture of a seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or other pipeline safety equipment, that is required to meet minimum safety standards for pipeline facilities under chapter 601 of title 49, United States Code."

Page 25, after line 13, insert the following:

9 "(3) EXEMPTION.—Paragraph (1)(C) shall not 10 apply with respect to a seal, hose, o-ring, gasket, or 11 other pipeline safety equipment, containing 12 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, that is 13 required to meet minimum safety standards for pipe3
