

AMENDMENT TO S. CON. RES. 33
OFFERED BY MS. WATERS OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 4109. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON THE FUNDING OF THE**
2 **BUREAU OF CONSUMER FINANCIAL PROTEC-**
3 **TION.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that—

5 (1) Congress should—

6 (A) immediately restore the funding of the
7 Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection by
8 setting the amount that may be transferred to
9 the Bureau in each fiscal year equal to 12 per-
10 cent of the total operating expenses of the Fed-
11 eral Reserve System, as reported in the Annual
12 Report, 2009, of the Board of Governors; and

13 (B) require that the Director of the Bu-
14 reau ensure that the Bureau has staffing levels
15 at least as high as the number of full time
16 equivalent staff as of December 31, 2024, in-
17 cluding having each division and office have at
18 a minimum the same staffing levels as they had
19 as of December 31, 2024; and

1 (2) the Director of the Bureau does not have
2 authority to issue stop work or other kinds of orders
3 for Bureau FTEs to carry out their statutory duties.
