

To require reporting on narco trafficking, corruption, and political repression in Albania and Serbia.

a. Report on Narco trafficking and Political Repression in Albania.—

1. In General.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State, in coordination with the Director of National Intelligence, shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees of Congress a classified report, prepared consistent with the protection of sources and methods, examining the extent of narco trafficking in Albania and the role of the government of Albania in facilitating this narco trafficking, that includes an examination of political repression by the government.

2. Appropriate Committees of Congress.—In this section, the term “appropriate committees of Congress” means—

the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate; and

the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives and the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House of Representatives.

b. Report on Russian and Chinese Influence in Serbia.—

1. In General.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act the Secretary of State, in coordination with the Director of National Intelligence, shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees of Congress an unclassified report with a classified annex, prepared consistent with the protection of sources and methods, examining the extent of Russian and Chinese influence in Serbia, particularly as regards efforts to deny United States persons business opportunities and the exploitation of corruption in the country by foreign malign actors.
