

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 116-57
OFFERED BY MR. MALINOWSKI OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of subtitle G of title XII, add the following:

1 **SEC. __. REPORT ON INCIDENTS OF ARBITRARY DETEN-**
2 **TION, VIOLENCE, AND STATE-SANCTIONED**
3 **HARASSMENT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF**
4 **EGYPT AGAINST UNITED STATES CITIZENS**
5 **AND THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS WHO ARE NOT**
6 **UNITED STATES CITIZENS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
9 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall submit
10 to the appropriate congressional committees a report on
11 incidents of arbitrary detention, violence, and state-san-
12 tioned harassment by the Government of Egypt against
13 United States citizens and their family members who are
14 not United States citizens, in both Egypt and in the
15 United States.

16 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-
17 quired by subsection (a) shall include the following:

18 (1) A detailed description of such incidents in
19 the past three years.

1 (2) A certification of whether such incidents
2 constitute a “pattern of acts of intimidation or har-
3 assment” for purposes of a Presidential determina-
4 tion in accordance with section 6 of the Arms Ex-
5 port Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2756).

6 (3) A statement of the Secretary of State’s in-
7 tent with regard to cancelling or suspending any let-
8 ters of offer, credits, guarantees, or export licenses
9 accorded to the Government of Egypt in accordance
10 with the provisions of section 6 of such Act.

11 (4) Any other actions taken to meaningfully
12 deter incidents of intimidation or harassment
13 against Americans and their families by such gov-
14 ernment’s security agencies.

15 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
16 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but the portions
17 of the report described in paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of
18 subsection (b) may contain a classified annex, so long as
19 such annex is provided separately from the unclassified re-
20 port.

21 (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
22 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-
23 gressional committees” means—

1 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
2 Committee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives; and

4 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
5 the Committee on Armed Services of the Senate.
