4 Section 5 of the National Voter Registration Act of
5 1993 (52 U.S.C. 20504) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new subsection:

7 "(f) Requirements Applicable to Certain8 States.—

9 "(1) IN GENERAL.—If an individual indicates in 10 a motor vehicle driver's license application that the 11 individual is not a citizen of the United States, the 12 appropriate State motor vehicle authority of a cov-13 ered State shall disclose such information to the 14 chief State election official of the State.

15 "(2) LIMITATION ON USE OF INFORMATION.—
16 The information described in paragraph (1) may not
17 be furnished by a State for the enforcement of the
18 immigration laws of the United States.

"(3) COVERED STATE DEFINED.—For purposes
 of this subsection, the term 'covered State' means a
 State in which—
 "(A) an alien who is not lawfully present
 in the United States is eligible for a motor vehi cle driver's license; and

7 "(B) an individual is automatically reg8 istered to vote upon acceptance of a completed
9 motor vehicle driver's license application.".
