

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4368, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MRS. CAMMACK OF FLORIDA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title) insert
the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds
2 made available by this Act may be used by the Secretary
3 of Agriculture to operate or enter into or renew a contract
4 for the procurement of an unmanned aircraft system
5 that—

6 (1) is manufactured by an entity—

7 (A) domiciled or headquartered in a cov-
8 ered foreign country; or

9 (B) under the control of the government of
10 a covered foreign country;

11 (2) uses flight controllers, radios, data trans-
12 mission devices, cameras, or gimbals manufactured
13 in a covered foreign country or by an entity domi-
14 ciled in a covered foreign country;

15 (3) uses a ground control system or operating
16 software developed in a covered foreign country or
17 by an entity domiciled in a covered foreign country;

1 (4) uses network connectivity or data storage
2 located in or administered by an entity domiciled in
3 a covered foreign country; or

4 (5) uses a system manufactured in a covered
5 foreign country or by an entity domiciled in a cov-
6 ered foreign country for the detection or identifica-
7 tion of unmanned aircraft systems.

8 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 (1) COVERED FOREIGN COUNTRY.—The term “cov-
10 ered foreign country” means the following:

11 (A) The People’s Republic of China.

12 (B) The Russian Federation.

13 (C) The Islamic Republic of Iran.

14 (D) The Democratic People’s Republic of
15 Korea.

16 (E) Any other country the government of which
17 is subject to sanctions imposed by the United States.

18 (2) UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM.—The term “un-
19 manned aircraft system” has the meaning given such term
20 in section 44801 of title 49, United States Code, and any
21 related services or equipment.
