At the end of subtitle C of title VII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 7___. SURVEY ON EFFECTS OF COVID-19 MANDATE ON 2 MATTERS RELATING TO RECRUITMENT AND 3 REINLISTMENT.

4 (a) SURVEY.—Not later than 30 days after the date 5 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense 6 shall conduct an anonymous survey to determine the ef-7 fects that the COVID-19 vaccine mandate issued by the 8 Secretary on August 24, 2021, has had on recruitment 9 to and reenlistment in the Armed Forces.

10 (b) MATTERS.—The survey under subsection (a)11 shall include an assessment of the following:

(1) Whether the announcement of the COVID13 19 vaccine mandate encouraged the reenlistment,
14 discouraged the reenlistment, or had any effect on
15 the reenlistment, of members of the Armed Forces.
16 (2) Whether the announcement of the COVID17 19 vaccine mandate encouraged individuals to join
18 the Armed Forces, discouraged individuals to join

1	the Armed Forces, or had any other effect on re-
2	cruitment efforts for the Armed Forces.

3 (c) Publication and Submission to Congress.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 240 days
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec6 retary shall submit to Congress the results of the
7 survey under subsection (a) and publish such results
8 on an internet website of the Department of De9 fense.

10 (2) PRIVACY CONSIDERATIONS.—In submitting 11 and publishing the results of the survey under para-12 graph (1), the Secretary shall ensure that such re-13 sults do not include any personally identifiable infor-14 mation of Armed Forces recruits, members of the 15 Armed Forces, or any other individual surveyed 16 under this section.
