

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-54**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. CAMMACK OF FLORIDA**

At the end of title LII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 52\_\_\_ . DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY RE-**  
2 **PORT RELATING TO ESTABLISHMENT OF**  
3 **PRECLEARANCE FACILITY IN TAIWAN.**

4 (a) REPORT.—

5 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days  
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-  
7 retary of Homeland Security, in consultation with  
8 the Secretary of Commerce, shall submit to the ap-  
9 propriate congressional committees a report that in-  
10 cludes an assessment of establishing a preclearance  
11 facility in Taiwan.

12 (2) ELEMENTS.—The assessment required  
13 under paragraph (1) shall include the following:

14 (A) An assessment with respect to the fea-  
15 sibility and advisability of establishing a CBP  
16 Preclearance facility in Taiwan.

17 (B) An assessment with respect to the na-  
18 tional security, homeland security, and law en-

1           forcement benefits of establishing a CBP  
2           Preclearance facility in Taiwan.

3           (C) An assessment of the impacts  
4           preclearance operations in Taiwan will have  
5           with respect to—

6                   (i) trade and travel, including impacts  
7                   on passengers traveling to the United  
8                   States; and

9                   (ii) CBP staffing.

10          (D) Country-specific information relating  
11          to—

12                   (i) anticipated benefits to the United  
13                   States; and

14                   (ii) security vulnerabilities associated  
15                   with such preclearance operations.

16          (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

17                  (1) The term “appropriate congressional com-  
18                  mittees” means—

19                          (A) the Committee on Homeland Security,  
20                          the Committee on Financial Services, and the  
21                          Committee on Ways and Means of the House of  
22                          Representatives; and

23                          (B) the Committee on Commerce, Science,  
24                          and Transportation, the Committee on Finance,

1           and the Joint Committee on Taxation of the  
2           Senate.

3           (2) The term “CBP” means U.S. Customs and  
4           Border Protection.
