At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XIII, insert the following:

1	SEC INTERNATIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION AND
2	TRAINING WITH TAIWAN.
3	(a) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
4	gress as follows:
5	(1) It is the common interest of the United
6	States and its allies and partners to strive for an
7	Indo-Pacific region that is free, open, inclusive,
8	healthy, anchored by democratic values, and uncon-
9	strained by coercion.
10	(2) The United States should work closely with
11	allies and partners as part of its integrated deter-
12	rence to respond to the pacing challenges in the
13	Indo-Pacific region.
14	(3) The pacing threats posed to Taiwan and in
15	the Indo-Pacific region require a robust education
16	and training program for Taiwan's armed forces and
17	greater interoperability and capabilities for joint op-
18	erations between United States and Taiwan.

1	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
2	authorized to be appropriated \$5,000,000 annually for
3	each of fiscal years 2023, 2024, and 2025 for assistance
4	authorized under section 541 of the Foreign Assistance
5	Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2347; relating to international
6	military education and training) for Taiwan. Assistance
7	using amounts so appropriated shall be made available for
8	the following purposes:
9	(1) Establishment of a rapport between the
10	United States military and Taiwan's military to
11	build a partnership for the future.
12	(2) Enhancement of interoperability and capa-
13	bilities for joint operations.
14	(3) Focus on professional military education.
15	(4) Training and education programs for any
16	military equipment to be delivered to Taiwan
17	(5) English Language Training assistance.
18	(6) Enable Taiwan to use its own funds to re-
19	ceive a reduced cost for Department of Defense edu-
20	cation and training.
