

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–33**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. CAMMACK OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVI, insert the following new section:

**SEC. 161I. STRATEGY FOR COUNTERING FOREIGN MALIGN INFLUENCE IN THE COGNITIVE DOMAIN.**

(a) **STRATEGY REQUIRED.**—Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the congressional defense committees a strategy for identifying, assessing, and countering foreign malign influence activities conducted in the cognitive domain by foreign adversaries.

(b) **ELEMENTS.**—The strategy required under subsection (a) shall include—

(1) an assessment of threats posed by foreign adversary disinformation, psychological operations, propaganda, and influence activities targeting members of the Armed Forces, military families, and United States national security interests;

(2) a description of existing Department of Defense capabilities to counter such activities;

(3) an assessment of capability gaps, organizational challenges, and resource requirements related to countering such activities; and

(4) recommendations for improving Department efforts to identify, deter, and counter foreign malign influence activities in the cognitive domain.

(c) **FORM.**—The strategy required under subsection (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form but may include a classified annex.
