

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119–33**

**OFFERED BY MRS. CAMMACK OF FLORIDA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XII, insert the following:

**SEC. 1211. ASSESSMENT OF ADVERSARY INFLUENCE OVER STRATEGIC MARITIME CHOKEPOINTS.**

(a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of Defense shall conduct an assessment of foreign adversary influence over strategic maritime chokepoints affecting United States national security interests.

(b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to the congressional defense committees a report on the assessment required under subsection (a), including—

(1) foreign adversary influence over the Panama Canal and associated port infrastructure;

(2) risks posed to United States military mobility and logistics;

(3) implications for regional security and commercial shipping; and

(4) recommendations to mitigate identified risks.
