## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117– 54

## OFFERED BY MR. WALTZ OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle E of title X, insert the following:

SEC. 10 PROHIBITION ON ACCESS TO UNITED STATES
MILITARY INSTALLATIONS BY OFFICIALS OF
STRATEGIC COMPETITOR OR ACUTE THREAT
COUNTRIES.
(a) In General.—
(1) Prohibition.—Except as provided in para-
graph (2). the Secretary of Defense shall prohibit
any official representing a covered country from ac-
cessing any United States military installation.
(2) WAIVER AUTHORITY.—The Secretary shall
waive the prohibition under paragraph (1) if the
Secretary determines access by the official is vital to
the national security interests of the United States.
(b) CONGRESSIONAL NOTICE REQUIREMENT.—If the
Secretary issues a waiver under subsection (a)(2), the Sec-
retary shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services
of the Senate and House of Representatives a report that
provides notice of the waiver and includes—

1	(1) the name of the official for whom the waiver
2	is issued;
3	(2) the country the official represents;
4	(3) the date of the visit to the military installa-
5	tion;
6	(4) the name of the military installation; and
7	(5) the reason for the waiver.
8	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
9	(1) The term "covered country" means a coun-
10	try identified as a strategic competitor or acute
11	threat in the national defense strategy submitted
12	pursuant to section 113(g) of title 10, United States
13	Code, for 2022.
14	(2) The term "military installation" has the
15	meaning given such term in section 2801 of title 10,
16	United States Code.
