

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 114-

OFFERED BY MR. CAPUANO OF MASSACHUSETTS

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1 **SEC. 6. DEATH BENEFITS FOR CAMPUS POLICE OFFICERS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1204 of the Omnibus
3 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
4 3796b) is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
6 (9) as paragraphs (2) through (10), respectively;

7 (2) by inserting the following before paragraph
8 (2) (as so redesignated):

9 “(1) ‘campus police officer’ means a police offi-
10 cer—

11 “(A) who is authorized to enforce the
12 criminal laws (including the authorization to
13 make arrests); and

14 “(B) who is employed by an institution of
15 higher education (as such term is defined in
16 section 101 of the Higher Education Act of
17 1965), including a police or similar department
18 operated by such institution;” and

19 (3) in paragraph (10) (as so redesignated)—

1 (A) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking
2 “or” at the end;

3 (B) in subparagraph (D), by striking the
4 period at the end and inserting “; or” ; and

5 (C) by inserting after subparagraph (D)
6 the following:

7 “(E) a campus police officer.”.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
9 this section shall apply with respect to a personal injury
10 sustained in the line of duty by a campus police officer
11 occurring on or after April 15, 2013.
