

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. CARBAJAL OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle E of title I, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 1 ____ . LIMITATION ON PROCUREMENT OF CUT FLOW-**
2 **ERS AND CUT GREENS.**

3 (a) **REQUIREMENT.—**

4 (1) **IN GENERAL.—**Funds appropriated or oth-
5 erwise available to the Department of Defense may
6 only be used for the procurement of a cut flower or
7 cut green if the cut flower or cut green is grown in
8 a qualifying area.

9 (2) **APPLICABILITY.—**This subsection shall
10 apply to a procurement made or contracted for—

11 (A) in the United States; and

12 (B) on or after the date that is 1 year
13 after the date of the enactment of this section.

14 (b) **GIFTS FOR DISPLAYS.—**

15 (1) **IN GENERAL.—**The Department of Defense
16 may only accept a gift of a cut flower or cut green
17 that is not grown in a qualifying area from a cov-
18 ered entity for the purpose of displaying the cut

1 flower or cut green if the origin of the cut flower or
2 cut green is clearly displayed at the time of delivery.

3 (2) REQUIREMENT.—If the Department of De-
4 fense accepts a gift of a cut flower or cut green from
5 a covered entity under paragraph (1), it shall clearly
6 display the origin of the cut flower or cut green dur-
7 ing the period of display of the cut flower or cut
8 green.

9 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

10 (1) The term “covered entity” means—

11 (A) a foreign government; and

12 (B) an agent of a foreign principal (as de-
13 fined section 1 of the Foreign Agents Registra-
14 tion Act of 1938 (22 U.S.C. 611)).

15 (2) The term “cut flower” means a flower re-
16 moved from a living plant for decorative use.

17 (3) The term “cut green” means a green, foli-
18 age, or branch removed from a living plant for deco-
19 rative use.

20 (4) The term “qualifying area” means—

21 (A) a State;

22 (B) the District of Columbia;

23 (C) a territory or possession of the United
24 States; or

1 (D) an area subject to the jurisdiction of
2 a federally recognized Indian Tribe.
