At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

1	SEC. 17 REPORT ON IMPACTS OF NORTH ATLANTIC

3	(a) In General.—Not later than one year after the
4	date of enactment of this Act, the Committee on Marine
5	Transportation System (in this section referred to as the
6	"Committee") shall provide to the Committees on Trans-
7	portation and Infrastructure and Natural Resources of the
8	House of Representatives and the Committee on Com-
9	merce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report
10	providing an analysis on the impact that an interim or
11	final rule from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Ad-
12	ministration that amends, updates, modifies, or replaces
13	the North Atlantic Right Whale vessel strike reduction
14	rule under section 224.105 of title 50, Code of Federal
15	Regulations, as in effect on the date of enactment of this
16	Act, will have on the United States Marine Transportation
17	System.

1	(b) Contents.—In conducting the report under sub-
2	section (a), the Committee shall consider the impact on
3	maritime safety and economic activity, including the im-
4	pacts of expanding the regulations under section 224.105
5	of title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, to include the
6	following:
7	(1) An expansion of the geographic areas cur-
8	rently subject to restrictions.
9	(2) A decrease to the minimum length of vessels
10	subject to speed restrictions.
11	(3) Establishing mandatory speed restrictions
12	in dynamic management areas where such restric-
13	tions are currently voluntary.
14	(c) Delay on Issuance of Final Rule.—The Ad-
15	ministrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Ad-
16	ministration may not issue an interim or final rule from
17	the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration
18	that amends, updates, modifies, or replaces the North At-
19	lantic Right Whale vessel strike reduction rule under sec-
20	tion 224.105 of title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, as
21	in effect on the date of enactment of this Act, until the
22	date that is 1 year after the date on which the Committee
23	submits the report as required under subsection (a).
