Add at the end of title IX the following:

1 SEC. 90006. IMMEDIATE EXPIRATION.

2 If Elon Musk is a special Government employee, as 3 such term is defined in section 202 of title 18, United 4 States Code, for more than 130 days in any period of 365 5 consecutive days during the period beginning on the date of the enactment of this title and ending on September 6 7 30, 2034, on the date that is the one hundred and thirty 8 first day that Elon Musk is a special Government em-9 ployee in such a period of 365 consecutive days—

10 (1) the amendments made by this title shall ter-11 minate and, effective on the day immediately fol-12 lowing such date, subsections (a) and (b) of section 13 8909 of title 5, United States Code, sections 7701, 14 8331(4), 8401(3), 8421(a), and 8422(a)(3) of such 15 title, subchapter I of chapter 33 of such title, and 16 section 302(a)(6) of the Federal Employee's Retire-17 ment System Act of 1986 (5 U.S.C. 8331 note), as 18 in effect on the date before the date of the enact-19 ment of this Act shall be revived;

(2) section 90005 of this title shall have no
 force or effect; and

3 (3) any contract between the Federal Govern4 ment and a business entity of which Elon Musk is
5 a majority owner shall be terminated.
