AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8 OFFERED BY MR. CASE OF HAWAII

At the end of subtitle B of title XIII, add the following:

1	SEC. 13 REPORT ON CIVILIAN-MILITARY RELATIONS IN
2	THE FREELY ASSOCIATED STATES.
3	(a) In General.—The Commander of United States
4	Indo-Pacific Command, acting through Joint Task Force-
5	Micronesia, shall be responsible for assessing and coordi-
6	nating military efforts to strengthen community relation-
7	ships between the United States Armed Forces and indi-
8	viduals living in the Freely Associated States (FAS) and
9	impacted by military installations, installations, and oper-
10	ating locations in the FAS. including through consultation
11	with each of the Armed Forces, other elements of United
12	States Indo-Pacific Command, and the Secretary of State.
13	(b) Report.—Not later than 180 days after the date
14	of the enactment of this Act, the Commander of United
15	States Indo-Pacific Command, acting through Joint Task
16	Force-Micronesia, shall submit to the congressional de-
17	fense committees a report that includes—

1	(1) the results of a study on the relationships
2	between civilians living in the FAS and Armed
3	Forces presence in the FAS;
4	(2) an assessment of such relationships;
5	(3) a summary of efforts by the Armed Forces
6	to improve such relationships to the extent affected
7	by United States military activities in the FAS;
8	(4) an identification of legally available, civilian-
9	military community engagement programs, activities,
10	and authorities with respect to the FAS;
11	(5) an identification of any new authorities
12	needed to implement existing DoD civilian-military
13	community engagement programs, activities, and au-
14	thorities in the FAS;
15	(6) an identification of any other components of
16	Federal departments or agencies required to imple-
17	ment any whole-of-government, civilian-military com-
18	munity engagement programs, activities, and au-
19	thorities in the FAS; and
20	(7) a plan and estimated cost for improving
21	such community engagement with respect to the im-
22	pact of United States military activities in the FAS.
