At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

4	(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
5	date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
6	of the United States shall provide a briefing, and submit
7	a report to the congressional defense committees con-
8	taining the results of an audit with respect to the inter-
9	national defense personnel exchange programs of the De-
10	partment of Defense, to assess the extent to which such
11	programs are coordinated across the Armed Forces, com-
12	batant commands, and defense agencies.
13	(b) PROGRAMS INCLUDED.—The report and briefing
14	required by subsection (a) shall include the following pro-
15	grams:
16	(1) Military Reserve Exchange Program.
17	(2) Engineer and Scientist Exchange Program.
18	(3) Foreign Academy Exchange Program.
19	(4) Personnel Exchange Program.

1	(5) All other Department of Defense funded ex-
2	change programs that enhance international co-
3	operation and military interoperability.
4	(c) Additional Matters.—The report required by
5	subsection (a) shall also include the following:
6	(1) An assessment of whether a centralized en-
7	tity within the Department of Defense oversees or
8	coordinates international defense personnel exchange
9	programs.
10	(2) An assessment of whether any policies, reg-
11	ulations, or directives mandate administration of
12	such programs across military services and defense
13	agencies.
14	(3) An assessment of whether the lack of co-
15	ordination has resulted in gaps in strategy, ineffi-
16	ciencies, or duplicative efforts.
17	(4) An assessment of any key factors that limit
18	the ability of the Department to host foreign per-
19	sonnel in an exchange program.
