AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117– OFFERED BY MR. CASE OF HAWAII

National Defense Authorization Bill

At the end of subtitle H of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 28 ANNUAL REPORT ON RENEWAL OF DEPART-
2	MENT OF DEFENSE EASEMENTS AND LEASES
3	OF LAND IN HAWAI'I.
4	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
5	(1) Lands throughout the State of Hawai'i,
6	which are currently owned and leased by the Depart-
7	ment of Defense or in which the Department of De-
8	fense otherwise has a real property interest, are crit-
9	ical to maintaining the readiness of the Armed
10	Forces now stationed or to be stationed in Hawai'i
11	and throughout the Indo-Pacific region and else-
12	where.
13	(2) Securing long-term continued utilization of
14	those lands by the Armed Forces is thus critical to
15	the national defense.
16	(3) As a result of various factors, including
17	complex land ownership and utilization issues and
18	competing actual and potential uses, the inter-

1 dependency of the various military components, and 2 the necessity of maintaining public support for the 3 presence and operations of the Armed Forces in Ha-4 wai'i, the realization of the congressional and De-5 partment of Defense goals of ensuring the continuity 6 of critical land and facilities infrastructure requires 7 a sustained, dedicated, funded, top-level effort to co-8 ordinate realization of these goals across the Armed 9 Forces, between the Department of Defense and 10 other agencies of the Federal Government, and be-11 tween the Department of Defense and the State of 12 Hawai'i and its civilian sector. 13 (4) The end result of this effort must account 14 for military and civilian concerns and for the chang-15 ing missions and needs of all components of the 16 Armed Forces stationed or otherwise operating out 17 of the State of Hawai'i as the Department of De-18 fense adjusts to meet the objectives outlined in the 19 National Defense Strategy. 20 (b) Annual Report.— 21 (1) Report required.—Not later than Feb-22 ruary 1 of each year, the Secretary of Defense shall 23 submit to the congressional defense committee a re-24 port describing the progress being made by the De-25 partment of Defense to renew each Department of

1	Defense land lease and easement in the State of
2	Hawai'i that—
3	(A) encompasses one acre or more; and
4	(B) will expire within 10 years after the
5	date of the submission of the report.
6	(2) Report elements.— Each report sub-
7	mitted under paragraph (1) shall include the fol-
8	lowing:
9	(A) The location, size, and expiration date
10	of each lease and easement.
11	(B) Major milestones and expected
12	timelines for maintaining access to the land
13	covered by each lease and easement.
14	(C) Actions completed over the preceding
15	two years for each lease and easement.
16	(D) Department-wide and service-specific
17	authorities governing each lease and easement
18	extension.
19	(E) A summary of coordination efforts be-
20	tween the Secretary of Defense and the Secre-
21	taries of the military departments.
22	(F) The status of efforts to develop an in-
23	ventory of military land in Hawai'i, including
24	current and possible future uses of the land,

1	that would assist in land negotiations with the
2	State of Hawai'i.
3	(G) The risks and potential solutions to
4	ensure the renewability of required and critical
5	leases and easements.
