At the appropriate place in subtitle A of title XIII, insert the following:

1	SEC STRATEGY FOR PACIFIC PARTNERSHIP.
2	(a) In General.—Not later than January 1, 2027,
3	and every 4 years thereafter, the President shall develop
4	and submit to the appropriate congressional committees
5	a strategy to be known as the "Strategy for Pacific Part-
6	nership" (in this section referred to as the "Strategy").
7	(b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The Strategy shall
8	include the following:
9	(1) A description of overarching goals for the
10	United States-Pacific Island Partnership.
11	(2) A description of measurable objectives for
12	United States engagement in the Pacific Islands.
13	(3) An assessment of threats to the Pacific Is-
14	lands region.
15	(4) A plan to address the security of the Pacific
16	Islands region.
17	(5) A strategy to invest in and improve critical
18	infrastructure.

1	(6) A regional Development Cooperation Strat-
2	egy formulated by the United States Agency for
3	International Development.
4	(c) Consultation.—In developing the Strategy, the
5	President should consult, as appropriate, with—
6	(1) regional organizations, such as the Pacific
7	Islands Forum, the Pacific Islands Development
8	Program, the Pacific Community, and the Secre-
9	tariat for the Pacific Regional Environment Pro-
10	gramme;
11	(2) the countries of the Pacific Islands;
12	(3) stakeholders such as civil society, faith-
13	based organizations, and non-state actors;
14	(4) United States allies and partners; and
15	(5) United States Pacific territories and States.
16	(d) Coordination.—In implementing the Strategy,
17	the President shall coordinate with the heads of other Fed-
18	eral departments and agencies, including the Secretary of
19	Defense, the Secretary of State, the Secretary of Home-
20	land Security, the Secretary of Commerce, the Adminis-
21	trator of United States Agency for International Develop-
22	ment, and the United States Trade Representative.
