

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE**  
**PRINT 117-54**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CASE OF HAWAII**

At the end of subtitle F of title X of division A, add the following:

1 **SEC. 10\_\_.** **DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE ENGAGEMENT**  
2 **WITH NATIVE HAWAIIAN ORGANIZATIONS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than March 30, 2023,  
4 the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Energy, Installa-  
5 tions, and Environment shall submit to the Committee on  
6 Armed Services of the House of Representatives a report  
7 on Department of Defense plans to identify, standardize,  
8 and coordinate best practices with respect to consultation  
9 and engagement with the Native Hawaiian community.

10 (b) **CONTENTS OF REPORT.**—The report required  
11 under subsection (a) shall include, at a minimum, the fol-  
12 lowing:

13 (1) Plans for conducting education and training  
14 programs relating to consultation and engagement  
15 with the Native Hawaiian community, including—

16 (A) outreach activities for fiscal years  
17 2023 and 2024; and

1 (B) the degree to which Native Hawaiian  
2 community members have been involved in de-  
3 velopment of curricula, tentative dates, loca-  
4 tions, required attendees, and topics for the  
5 education and training programs.

6 (2) A list of all Native Hawaiian community  
7 groups involved or to be involved in the consultation  
8 process to update Department of Defense Instruc-  
9 tion 4710.03 (or any successor document).

10 (3) A description of how Department of De-  
11 fense Instruction 4710.03 can be improved to reflect  
12 best practices and provide continuity across the mili-  
13 tary departments in practices, policies, training, and  
14 personnel who conduct consultation with the Native  
15 Hawaiian community.

16 (4) A timeline for issuing the next update or  
17 successor document to Department of Defense In-  
18 struction 4710.03.

19 (5) A description of how the Department of De-  
20 fense can enhance and expand education and train-  
21 ing programs relating to consultation and engage-  
22 ment with the Native Hawaiian community and out-  
23 reach activities for all commands and installations  
24 within the State of Hawaii.
