

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-33
OFFERED BY MR. CASTRO OF TEXAS

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . PROVIDING APPROPRIATE RECOGNITION AND**
2 **TREATMENT NEEDED TO ENHANCE RELA-**
3 **TIONS ACT.**

4 (a) EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO
5 THE ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEAST ASIAN NATIONS.—The
6 International Organizations Immunities Act (22 U.S.C.
7 288 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following
8 new section:

9 **“SEC. 18. EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO**
10 **THE ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHEAST ASIAN NA-**
11 **TIONS.**

12 “Under such terms and conditions as the President
13 shall determine, the President is authorized to extend the
14 provisions of this title to the Association of Southeast
15 Asian Nations in the same manner, to the same extent,
16 and subject to the same conditions, as it may be extended
17 to a public international organization in which the United
18 States participates pursuant to any treaty or under the
19 authority of any Act of Congress authorizing such partici-

1 pation or making an appropriation for such participa-
2 tion.”.

3 (b) EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO
4 THE EUROPEAN ORGANIZATION FOR NUCLEAR RE-
5 SEARCH (CERN).—The International Organizations Im-
6 munities Act (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) is amended by add-
7 ing at the end the following new section:

8 **“SEC. 19. EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO**
9 **THE EUROPEAN ORGANIZATION FOR NU-**
10 **CLEAR RESEARCH (CERN).**

11 “Under such terms and conditions as the President
12 shall determine, the President is authorized to extend the
13 provisions of this title to the European Organization for
14 Nuclear Research (CERN) in the same manner, to the
15 same extent, and subject to the same conditions, as it may
16 be extended to a public international organization in which
17 the United States participates pursuant to any treaty or
18 under the authority of any Act of Congress authorizing
19 such participation or making an appropriation for such
20 participation.”.

21 (c) EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO
22 THE PACIFIC ISLANDS FORUM.—The International Orga-
23 nizations Immunities Act (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) is
24 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

1 **“SEC. 20. EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO**
2 **THE PACIFIC ISLANDS FORUM.**

3 “Under such terms and conditions as the President
4 shall determine, the President is authorized to extend the
5 provisions of this title to the Pacific Islands Forum in the
6 same manner, to the same extent, and subject to the same
7 conditions, as it may be extended to a public international
8 organization in which the United States participates pur-
9 suant to any treaty or under the authority of any Act of
10 Congress authorizing such participation or making an ap-
11 propriation for such participation.”

12 (d) EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO
13 THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY.—The International Orga-
14 nizations Immunities Act (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) is
15 amended by adding at the end the following new section:
16 **“SEC. 21. EXTENSION OF PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES TO**
17 **THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY.**

18 “Under such terms and conditions as the President
19 shall determine, the President is authorized to extend the
20 provisions of this title to the Caribbean Community in the
21 same manner, to the same extent, and subject to the same
22 conditions, as it may be extended to a public international
23 organization in which the United States participates pur-
24 suant to any treaty or under the authority of any Act of
25 Congress authorizing such participation or making an ap-
26 propriation for such participation.”

1 (e) EXTENSION OF CERTAIN PRIVILEGES AND IMMUN-
2 NITIES TO THE AFRICAN UNION.—Section 12(b) of the
3 International Organizations Immunities Act (22 U.S.C.
4 288f–2(b)) is amended:

5 (1) by striking “to extend, or enter into an
6 agreement to extend, to the African Union Mission”
7 and inserting “to extend, or enter into an agreement
8 to extend—”;

9 “(1) to the African Union Mission”;

10 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
11 ing “; and”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following new
13 paragraph:

14 “(2) to the permanent observer mission of the
15 African Union to the United Nations in New York,
16 and to its members, the privileges and immunities
17 enjoyed by the permanent missions to the United
18 Nations of member states, and their members, sub-
19 ject to corresponding conditions and obligations.”.
