

1 “(3) summarizes the monetary value of con-
2 tracts awarded pursuant to each such waiver;

3 “(4) provides the justification for each such
4 waiver, including the specific law, treaty, or inter-
5 national agreement under which the waiver was
6 granted;

7 “(5) summarizes the funds expended on—

8 “(A) steel, iron, and manufactured goods
9 produced in the United States for projects with
10 respect to which a surface transportation Buy
11 America requirement, under which the Sec-
12 retary has waiver authority, applied during the
13 preceding calendar year; and

14 “(B) steel, iron, and manufactured goods
15 produced outside the United States for projects
16 with respect to which the Secretary issued a
17 waiver from a surface transportation Buy
18 America requirement during the preceding cal-
19 endar year; and

20 “(6) provides an employment impact analysis of
21 the cumulative effect of all waivers from a surface
22 transportation Buy America requirement issued by
23 the Secretary during the preceding calendar year on
24 manufacturing employment in the United States.”.
