

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 115-70**  
**OFFERED BY MR. CICILLINE OF RHODE ISLAND**

Add at the end of subtitle F of title XII the following:

**1 SEC. 12 \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON ARMS EMBARGO ON CYPRUS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense  
4 and the Secretary of State shall jointly submit to the ap-  
5 propriate congressional committees a report on the current  
6 impact of the United States arms embargo on Cyprus.

7 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-  
8 quired under subsection (a) shall include the following:

9 (1) A list of items that have been requested by  
10 the Republic of Cyprus from the United States, but  
11 have been denied under the arms embargo referred  
12 to in such subsection.

13 (2) An analysis of the impact that lifting the  
14 arms embargo would have on United States interests  
15 related to the island of Cyprus and the Eastern  
16 Mediterranean region.

17 (3) An analysis of how the arms embargo is  
18 being complied with in areas controlled by the Re-  
19 public of Cyprus, and in occupied northern Cyprus,

1       and whether any party has violated the letter or  
2       spirit of the arms embargo, as specified in United  
3       States policy for the Eastern Mediterranean region  
4       under section 620C(b)(3) of the Foreign Assistance  
5       Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2373(b)(3)).

6           (4) An analysis of how the arms embargo  
7       against Cyprus impacts the ability of the United  
8       States and its partners to combat threats in the  
9       Mediterranean region.

10       (c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)  
11       shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may contain  
12       a classified annex.

13       (d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES  
14       DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-  
15       gressional committees” means—

16           (1) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
17       Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-  
18       resentatives; and

19           (2) the Committee on Armed Services and the  
20       Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
