At the end of subtitle E of title XVII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 17__ . DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY CISA**
2 **DIRECTOR TERM LIMITATION.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (b) of section 2202 of
4 the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 652) is
5 amended by—

6 (1) redesignating paragraph (2) as paragraph
7 (4); and

8 (2) inserting after paragraph (1) the following
9 new paragraphs:

10 “(2) QUALIFICATIONS.—

11 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Director shall be
12 appointed from among individuals who have—

13 “(i) extensive knowledge in at least
14 two of the areas specified in subparagraph
15 (B); and

16 “(ii) not fewer than five years of dem-
17 onstrated experience in efforts to foster co-
18 ordination and collaboration between the

1 Federal Government, the private sector,
2 and other entities on issues related to cy-
3 bersecurity, infrastructure security, or se-
4 curity risk management.

5 “(B) SPECIFIED AREAS.—The areas speci-
6 fied in this subparagraph are the following:

7 “(i) Cybersecurity.

8 “(ii) Infrastructure security.

9 “(iii) Security risk management.

10 “(3) TERM.—Effective with respect to an indi-
11 vidual appointed to be the Director by the President,
12 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
13 after the date of the enactment of this paragraph,
14 the term of office of such an individual so appointed
15 shall be five years, and such an individual may not
16 serve more than two terms. The term of office of the
17 individual serving as the Director as of such date of
18 enactment shall be five years beginning on the date
19 on which the Director began serving.”.

20 (b) CHANGE OF TITLE OF ASSISTANT DIRECTOR TO
21 EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR.—

22 (1) CYBERSECURITY DIVISION.—Section 2203
23 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C.
24 653) is amended—

25 (A) in subsection (a)—

1 (i) in the heading for paragraph (2),
2 by striking “ASSISTANT DIRECTOR” and
3 inserting “EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT DIREC-
4 TOR”; and

5 (ii) in paragraph (2), by striking “As-
6 sistant Director for Cybersecurity (in this
7 section referred to as the ‘Assistant Direc-
8 tor’)” and inserting “Executive Assistant
9 Director for Cybersecurity (in this section
10 referred to as the ‘Executive Assistant Di-
11 rector’)”; and

12 (B) by striking “Assistant Director” each
13 place it appears and inserting “Executive As-
14 sistant Director”.

15 (2) INFRASTRUCTURE SECURITY DIVISION.—
16 Section 2204 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
17 (6 U.S.C. 654) is amended—

18 (A) in subsection (a)—

19 (i) in the heading for paragraph (2),
20 by striking “ASSISTANT DIRECTOR” and
21 inserting “EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT DIREC-
22 TOR”; and

23 (ii) in paragraph (2), by striking “As-
24 sistant Director for Infrastructure Security
25 (in this section referred to as the ‘Assist-

1 ant Director’))” and inserting “Executive
2 Assistant Director for Infrastructure Secu-
3 rity (in this section referred to as the ‘Ex-
4 ecutive Assistant Director’)”; and

5 (B) by striking “Assistant Director” each
6 place it appears and inserting “Executive As-
7 sistant Director”.

8 (c) AMENDMENT RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS FOR
9 CERTAIN CISA EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT DIRECTORS.—
10 The Homeland Security Act of 2002 is amended—

11 (1) in subparagraph (B) of section 2203(a)(2)
12 (6 U.S.C. 653(a)(2)), by striking “President without
13 the advice and consent of the Senate” and inserting
14 “Secretary”; and

15 (2) in subparagraph (B) of section 2204(a)(2)
16 (6 U.S.C. 654(a)(2)), by striking “President without
17 the advice and consent of the Senate” and inserting
18 “Secretary”.

19 (d) AMENDMENT TO POSITION LEVEL OF CISA DI-
20 RECTOR.—Subchapter II of chapter 53 of title 5, United
21 States Code, is amended—

22 (1) in section 5313, by inserting after “Admin-
23 istrator of the Transportation Security Administra-
24 tion.” the following:

1 “Director, Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Se-
2 curity Agency.”; and
3 (2) in section 5314, by striking “Director, Cy-
4 bersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency.”.
