

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT**

**119–8**

**OFFERED BY MR. CISCOMANI OF ARIZONA**

At the end of subtitle C of title II, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 2\_\_\_\_. REPORT ON ELECTRONIC WARFARE CAPA-**  
2 **BILITY FOR UNMANNED SURFACE VESSELS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days from the  
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Assistant Secretary  
5 of the Navy for Research, Development, and Acquisition  
6 shall submit to the congressional defense committees an  
7 unclassified report on planned development of a  
8 configurable, low-cost, expendable electronic warfare capa-  
9 bility to support unmanned surface vessel survivability.

10 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report required under sub-  
11 section (a) shall include the following:

12 (1) An assessment of currently available elec-  
13 tronic warfare capabilities for unmanned surface  
14 vessels and limitations of current technology.

15 (2) A determination of funding availability for  
16 fiscal years 2026 through 2030 by program element  
17 to support the rapid development of configurable

1 low-cost electronic warfare capabilities for multi-  
2 class unmanned surface vessels.

3 (3) A determination of funding availability from  
4 Public Law 119–21.

5 (4) An assessment of current and future sat-  
6 ellite radar detection capabilities in finding and  
7 tracking ocean-going unmanned surface vessels by  
8 any country determined by the Secretary of State to  
9 be a foreign adversary with such capabilities.

10 (5) A list of possible technical requirements for  
11 a multi-class, affordable, low-power, and expendable  
12 electronic warfare system.

13 (6) A rapid acquisition strategy for this capa-  
14 bility.
