

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-3
OFFERED BY MR. CISNEROS OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of title II, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____.** **LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS PEND-**
2 **ING INFORMATION ON DEPARTMENT OF DE-**
3 **FENSE COORDINATION WITH THE UNITED**
4 **STATES DOGE SERVICE.**

5 (a) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—Of the funds made avail-
6 able by this title for the Department of Defense, not more
7 than \$100,000,000,000 may be obligated or expended
8 until the Secretary of Defense submits to the congres-
9 sional defense committees a report on the actions under-
10 taken by the Department of Defense pursuant to coordina-
11 tion or consultation with the United States Department
12 of Government Efficiency Service (referred to in this sec-
13 tion as “DOGE”).

14 (b) **ELEMENTS.**—The report required under sub-
15 section (a) shall include the following:

16 (1) Identification of the congressionally author-
17 ized and appropriated funds used to conduct liaison,
18 analysis, management, or other activities with
19 DOGE.

1 (2) Identification of Department of Defense fa-
2 cilities, personnel, and support resources assigned to
3 or supporting DOGE-related activities.

4 (3) Management and reporting structures for
5 DOGE-related decision making, including how
6 DOGE analysis and decision making interacts with
7 the planning, programming, budgeting, and execu-
8 tion process and other existing management and
9 programming structures and practices of the De-
10 partment of Defense.

11 (4) Analytical methodologies and processes used
12 in support of each action conducted in coordination
13 with DOGE, including an explanation of how such
14 actions differ from existing methodologies and proc-
15 esses of the Department of Defense.

16 (5) Processes by which an internal or external
17 entity affected by DOGE-related activities is able to
18 appeal decisions made pursuant to such activities.

19 (6) Any exceptions to Department of Defense
20 standards, instructions, or policies provided in sup-
21 port of DOGE activities.
