

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116-**

**OFFERED BY MS. CLARKE OF NEW YORK**

Page 143, after line 24 (relating to the establishment of the Steering Committee on Emerging Technology), add the following new subsection:

1       (g) DEEPPFAKE WORKING GROUP.—

2           (1) IN GENERAL.—The co-chairs shall establish  
3       a working group, in coordination with the Defense  
4       Advanced Research Project Agency and such other  
5       departments and agencies of the Federal Govern-  
6       ment as the co-chairs deem appropriate, to—

7           (A) inform the Steering Committee’s ac-  
8       tivities with respect to the national security im-  
9       plications of machine-manipulated media (com-  
10      monly known as “deepfakes”);

11          (B) assess the Federal Government’s capa-  
12      bilities with respect to technologies to detect, or  
13      otherwise counter and combat, machine-manip-  
14      ulated media and other advanced image manip-  
15      ulation methods;

16          (C) assess the machine-manipulated media  
17      capabilities of foreign countries and non-state

1 actors, with particular emphasis on the People’s  
2 Republic of China and the Russian Federation;  
3 and

4 (D) provide recommendations to the Steer-  
5 ing Committee on the matters described in sub-  
6 paragraphs (A) through (C).

7 (2) MACHINE-MANIPULATED MEDIA DE-  
8 FINED.—In this subsection, the term “machine-ma-  
9 nipulated media” has the meaning given that term  
10 in section 5724(d) of the National Defense Author-  
11 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2020 (Public Law 116–  
12 92).

Page 144, line 1, strike “(g)” and insert “(h)”.

Page 144, line 7, after “intelligence” insert “(includ-  
ing deepfake videos and related technologies)”.
