1SEC. 9503. REQUIRING EQUAL APPLICATION OF LAWS TO2MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any provision of law that provides an exception 4 5 in its application to a Member of Congress or an employee of the office of a Member of Congress shall have no effect. 6 7 (b) CLARIFICATION RELATING TO EXERCISE OF OF-FICIAL OR REPRESENTATIONAL DUTIES.—Subsection (a) 8 shall not be construed to apply to provisions of law or rules 9 which permit Members of Congress or employees of offices 10 11 of Members of Congress to carry out official duties that are tied directly to lawmaking, including provisions or 12 rules permitting Members and employees to enter and use 13 14 the United States Capitol, the United States Capitol grounds, and other buildings and facilities. 15

(c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term "Member
of Congress" means a Senator or a Representative in, or
Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
