Page 786, insert after line 7 the following new subtitle:

1 **Subtitle F—Clean Congress**

2 **SEC. 9501. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This subtitle may be cited as the “Citizen Legislature
4 Anti-Corruption Reform of Congress Act” or the
5 “CLEAN Congress Act”.

6 **SEC. 9502. PROHIBITING MULTIPLE SUBJECTS IN SINGLE**
7 **BILL.**

8 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Each bill, order, resolution, or
9 vote submitted by Congress to the President under section
10 7 of article I of the Constitution of the United States shall
11 embrace no more than one subject, and that subject shall
12 be clearly and descriptively expressed in the title of the
13 bill, order, resolution or vote.

14 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Subsection (a) shall apply
15 with respect to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress and
16 each succeeding Congress.

1 **SEC. 9503. REQUIRING EQUAL APPLICATION OF LAWS TO**
2 **MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-
4 sion of law, any provision of law that provides an exception
5 in its application to a Member of Congress or an employee
6 of the office of a Member of Congress shall have no effect.

7 (b) **CLARIFICATION RELATING TO EXERCISE OF OF-**
8 **FICIAL OR REPRESENTATIONAL DUTIES.**—Subsection (a)
9 shall not be construed to apply to provisions of law or rules
10 which permit Members of Congress or employees of offices
11 of Members of Congress to carry out official duties that
12 are tied directly to lawmaking, including provisions or
13 rules permitting Members and employees to enter and use
14 the United States Capitol, the United States Capitol
15 grounds, and other buildings and facilities.

16 (c) **DEFINITION.**—In this section, the term “Member
17 of Congress” means a Senator or a Representative in, or
18 Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress.
