Page 786, after line 7, insert the following new subtitle (and redesignate the subsequent subtitle accordingly):

1 **Subtitle F—Retirement Benefits for**  
2 **Members of Congress**

3 **SEC. 9501. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This subtitle may be cited as the “Citizen Legislature  
5 Anti-Corruption Reform of Public Service Act” or the  
6 “CLEAN Public Service Act”.

7 **SEC. 9502. TERMINATION OF FURTHER RETIREMENT BENE-**  
8 **FITS FOR MEMBERS OF CONGRESS.**

9 (a) AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE CIVIL SERVICE  
10 RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter III of chapter  
12 83 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by in-  
13 serting after section 8335 the following:

14 **“§ 8335a. Termination of further retirement coverage**  
15 **of Members of Congress**

16 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
17 vision of this subchapter and subject to subsection (f), ef-

1 fective on the date that is 90 days after the date of enact-  
2 ment of this section—

3 “(1) a Member shall not be subject to this sub-  
4 chapter for any further period of time; and

5 “(2) no further Government contributions or  
6 deductions from basic pay may be made with respect  
7 to such Member for deposit in the Treasury of the  
8 United States to the credit of the Fund.

9 “(b) PRIOR RIGHTS NOT AFFECTED.—Nothing in  
10 subsection (a) shall be considered to nullify, modify, or  
11 otherwise affect any right, entitlement, or benefit under  
12 this subchapter with respect to any Member covering any  
13 period prior to the date of enactment of this section.

14 “(c) RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THRIFT SAVINGS  
15 PLAN NOT AFFECTED.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall  
16 affect the eligibility of a Member to participate in the  
17 Thrift Savings Plan in accordance with otherwise applica-  
18 ble provisions of law.

19 “(d) REGULATIONS.—Any regulations necessary to  
20 carry out this section may—

21 “(1) except with respect to matters relating to  
22 the Thrift Savings Plan, be prescribed by the Direc-  
23 tor of the Office of Personnel Management; and

1           “(2) with respect to matters relating to the  
2 Thrift Savings Plan, be prescribed by the Executive  
3 Director (as defined by section 8401(13)).

4           “(e) EXCLUSION.—For purposes of this section, the  
5 term ‘Member’ does not include the Vice President.”.

6           (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-  
7 tions at the beginning of chapter 83 of title 5,  
8 United States Code, is amended by inserting after  
9 the item relating to section 8335 the following:

“8335a. Termination of further retirement coverage of Members of Congress.”.

10          (b) AMENDMENTS RELATING TO THE FEDERAL EM-  
11 PLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

12           (1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 84  
13 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by insert-  
14 ing after section 8425 the following:

15          **“§ 8425a. Termination of further retirement coverage**  
16                 **of Members of Congress**

17           “(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
18 vision of this chapter, effective on the date that is 90 days  
19 after the date of enactment of this section—

20           “(1) subject to subsection (f), in the case of an  
21 individual who first becomes a Member before such  
22 date of enactment—

23           “(A) such Member shall not be subject to  
24 this chapter for any further period of time after  
25 such date of enactment; and

1           “(B) no further Government contributions  
2           or deductions from basic pay may be made with  
3           respect to such Member for deposit in the  
4           Treasury of the United States to the credit of  
5           the Fund; and

6           “(2) in the case of an individual who first be-  
7           comes a Member on or after such date of enact-  
8           ment—

9           “(A) such Member shall not be subject to  
10          this chapter; and

11          “(B) no Government contributions or de-  
12          ductions from basic pay may be made with re-  
13          spect to such Member for deposit in the Treas-  
14          ury of the United States to the credit of the  
15          Fund.

16          “(b) PRIOR RIGHTS NOT AFFECTED.—Nothing in  
17          subsection (a) shall be considered to nullify, modify, or  
18          otherwise affect any right, entitlement, or benefit under  
19          this chapter with respect to any Member covering any pe-  
20          riod prior to the date of enactment of this section.

21          “(c) RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE IN THRIFT SAVINGS  
22          PLAN NOT AFFECTED.—Nothing in subsection (a) shall  
23          affect the eligibility of a Member to participate in the  
24          Thrift Savings Plan in accordance with otherwise applica-  
25          ble provisions of law.

1 “(d) REGULATIONS.—

2 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Any regulations necessary  
3 to carry out this section may—

4 “(A) except with respect to matters relat-  
5 ing to the Thrift Savings Plan, be prescribed by  
6 the Director of the Office of Personnel Manage-  
7 ment; and

8 “(B) with respect to matters relating to  
9 the Thrift Savings Plan, be prescribed by the  
10 Executive Director (as defined by section  
11 8401(13)).

12 “(2) REFUNDS.—Notwithstanding subsection  
13 (b), the regulations under paragraph (1)(A) shall, in  
14 the case of a Member who has not completed at  
15 least 5 years of civilian service as of the date of en-  
16 actment of this section, provide that the lump-sum  
17 credit shall be payable to such Member to the same  
18 extent and in the same manner as if such Member  
19 satisfied paragraphs (1) through (4) of section  
20 8424(a) as of such date of enactment.

21 “(e) EXCLUSIONS.—For purposes of this section, the  
22 term ‘Member’ does not include the Vice President.”.
