Page 241, line 10, strike “and”.

Page 241, after line 10, insert the following:

1 (2) by amending paragraph (3)(I) to read as
2 follows:

3 “(I) the provision of nonfixed route para-
4 transit transportation services in accordance
5 with section 223 of the Americans with Disabil-
6 ities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12143), but only
7 for grant recipients that are in compliance with
8 applicable requirements of that Act, including
9 both fixed route and demand responsive service,
10 and only for amounts—

11 “(i) not to exceed 10 percent of such
12 recipient’s annual formula apportionment
13 under sections 5307 and 5311; or

14 “(ii) not to exceed 20 percent of such
15 recipient’s annual formula apportionment

1 under sections 5307 and 5311, if con-
2 sistent with guidance issued by the Sec-
3 retary, the recipient demonstrates that the
4 recipient meets at least one of the fol-
5 lowing requirements:

6 “(I) Provides an active fixed
7 route travel training program that is
8 available for riders with disabilities.

9 “(II) Provides that all fixed route
10 and paratransit operators participate
11 in a passenger safety, disability
12 awareness, and sensitivity training
13 class on at least a biennial basis.

14 “(III) Has memoranda of under-
15 standing in place with employers and
16 American Job Centers to increase ac-
17 cess to employment opportunities for
18 people with disabilities.”.
