3	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
4	United States shall conduct a study on the reporting of
5	alcohol-impaired driving arrest and citation results into
6	Federal databases to facilitate the widespread identifica-
7	tion of repeat impaired driving offenders.
8	(b) Inclusions.—The study conducted under sub-
9	section (a) shall include a detailed assessment of—
10	(1) the extent to which State and local criminal
11	justice agencies are reporting alcohol-impaired driv-
12	ing arrest and citation results into Federal data-
13	bases;
14	(2) barriers on the Federal, State, and local lev-
15	els to the reporting of alcohol-impaired driving ar-
16	rest and citation results into Federal databases, as
17	well as barriers to the use of those systems by crimi-
18	nal justice agencies;

1	(3) Federal, State, and local resources available
2	to improve the reporting of alcohol-impaired driving
3	arrest and citation results into Federal databases;
4	(4) recommendations for policies and programs
5	to be carried out by the National Highway Traffic
6	Safety Administration; and
7	(5) recommendations for programs and grant
8	funding to be authorized by Congress.
9	(c) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
10	of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the
11	United States shall submit to the appropriate committees
12	of Congress a report on the results of the study conducted
13	under subsection (a).
