## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 116–57 OFFERED BY MR. COHEN OF TENNESSEE

At the end of subtitle D of title XII, add the following:

1	SEC REPORT ON PRESENCE OF RUSSIAN MILITARY
2	FORCES IN OTHER FOREIGN COUNTRIES.
3	(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
4	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of De-
5	fense, in consultation with the Secretary of State, shall
6	submit to the appropriate congressional committees a re-
7	port that contains the following:
8	(1) A list of foreign countries that have con-
9	sented to host military forces of Russia, including a
10	description of—
11	(A) any agreement between each country
12	and Russia to host such forces;
13	(B) the number of Russian military forces
14	that are present in each country;
15	(C) the location of Russian military forces
16	that are present in each country;
17	(D) the types of Russian military force
18	structures that are present in each country;

1	(E) the level and type of United States se-
2	curity assistance provided to each country; and
3	(F) any military exercises that Russian
4	forces have undertaken with each country.
5	(2) A list of foreign countries with respect to
6	which Russia has deployed military forces in viola-
7	tion of the territorial sovereignty of such countries,
8	including a description of—
9	(A) the number of Russian military forces
10	that are present in each country;
11	(B) the location of Russian military forces
12	that are present in each country; and
13	(C) the types of Russian military force
14	structures that are present in each country.
15	(b) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
16	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
17	a classified annex.
18	(c) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
19	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
20	sional committees" means—
21	(1) the congressional defense committees;
22	(2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
23	Committee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-
24	resentatives: and

- 1 (3) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
- 2 the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate.
