10	(A) more effective than punitive, exclu-
11	sionary measures;
12	(B) improve student achievement; and
13	(C) enhance public safety and student-well-
14	being; and
15	(3) determine the long-term benefits of replac-
16	ing a punitive approach to discipline with restorative
17	practices in schools, by analyzing the potential sav-

- 3 (b) Cost-benefit Analysis.—The study conducted
- 4 under subsection (a) shall include a cost-benefit analysis

- 7 school climate and student discipline.
- 8 (c) Report.—Upon the conclusion of the study
- 9 under subsection (a), the Comptroller General of the
- 10 United States shall prepare and submit to Congress a re-
- 11 port regarding the study and the conclusions and rec-
- 12 ommendations generated from the study.
