Add at the end of subtitle F of title X the following new section:

1	SEC. 10 REPORT ON EFFECT ON DEPARTMENT OF DE-
2	FENSE OF SHUTDOWN OF METRORAIL.
3	(a) Report.—Not later than 90 days after the date
4	of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
5	shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
6	port detailing the impact of a partial or complete shut-
7	down of Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority
8	Metrorail (Metrorail) on employees of the Department of
9	Defense and on installations of the Department of Defense
10	which are served by Metrorail in the National Capital Re-
11	gion.
12	(b) Elements of Report.—The report required by
13	subsection (a) shall include the following elements:
14	(1) The number of employees who receive Met-
15	rorail transit benefits.
16	(2) The number of installations in the National
17	Capital Region within two miles of a Metrorail sta-

1	tion and the number of employees assigned to those
2	installations.
3	(3) The number of employees with telework
4	agreements, the number of employees teleworking on
5	a regular basis, and the number of pending requests
6	for telework agreements.
7	(4) The number of unscheduled leave requests
8	related to Metrorail service disruptions in the pre-
9	ceding fiscal year.
10	(5) The Department's contingency plans in the
11	event of a partial or complete shutdown of Metrorail
12	(c) Coordination With State and Local Enti-
13	TIES.— In preparing the report required by subsection
14	(a), the Secretary of Defense may work in conjunction and
15	coordinate with the States, units of local government
16	other Federal departments and agencies, and other enti-
17	ties which would be affected by a partial or complete shut-
18	down of Metrorail.
