

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–36
OFFERED BY MR. CONNOLLY OF VIRGINIA

At the end of subtitle A of title XII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 12 ____ . DATABASE ON INTERNATIONAL MILITARY STUDENTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the confidentiality requirements under section 222(f) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1202(f)), the Secretary of Defense, in coordination with the Secretary of State, shall develop and implement a database for storing information on and tracking the status of covered international military students that also includes each of the following matters with respect to such students:

11 (1) The name and identifying information of the student, including foreign government and passport number (unless authorized by United States law or international agreements to travel to the United States without a passport).

16 (2) Any aliases of the student.

17 (3) The dates and duration of the student's past, current, and planned international military student training.

1 (4) Current visa information for the student,
2 including visa type and number, unless the student
3 is a United States dual national or is authorized by
4 United States law or international agreements to
5 travel to the United States without a visa.

6 (b) UPDATE PERMITTED.—The requirement to de-
7 velop a database under this section may be satisfied by
8 updating the existing Security Cooperation-Training Man-
9 agement System to include each matter described in sub-
10 section (a).

11 (c) COVERED INTERNATIONAL MILITARY STUDENTS
12 DEFINED.—For purposes of the database required by this
13 section, the term “covered international military student”
14 means a foreign national that is participating in the
15 United States in—

16 (1) any security assistance program authorized
17 under the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22
18 U.S.C. 2151 et seq.) and funded by the Department
19 of State, such as the International Military Edu-
20 cation and Training program;

21 (2) any security cooperation program author-
22 ized under title 10, United States Code, and funded
23 by the Department of Defense; or

1 (3) any training purchased by a foreign coun-
2 try's national funds through the foreign military
3 sales program.
