AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1735, AS REPORTED OFFERED BY MR. CONYERS OF MICHIGAN

At the end of subtitle A of title XII of the bill, add the following:

1	SEC. 12xx. ANNUAL REPORT ON SECURITY ASSISTANCE RE-
2	LATED PROGRAMS CARRIED OUT BY THE DE-
3	PARTMENT OF DEFENSE.
4	(a) Annual Report Required.—As part of the an-
5	nual defense authorization request transmitted to Con-
6	gress under section 113a of title 10, United States Code,
7	the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the congressional
8	defense committees a report on security assistance related
9	programs carried out by the Department of Defense.
10	(b) Elements.—
11	(1) In General.—Each report required under
12	subsection (a) shall include the following:
13	(A) A description of the security assistance
14	related programs carried out by the Depart-
15	ment of Defense during the preceding fiscal
16	year, including the authorities for such pro-
17	grams, the amounts expended for such pro-
18	grams, and the results achieved through such
19	programs.

1	(B) A description of the security assistance
2	related programs being carried, or to be carried
3	out, by the Department of Defense in the cur-
4	rent fiscal year, including the authorities for
5	such programs, the amounts expended or
6	planned to be expended for such programs, and
7	the goals achieved or to be achieved through
8	such programs.
9	(C) A description of any security assist-
10	ance related program planned to be carried out
11	by the Department of Defense in the next fiscal
12	year, including the authorities for such pro-
13	grams, the amounts planned to be expended for
14	such programs, and the goals to be achieved
15	through such programs.
16	(2) Presentation.—Each report required
17	under subsection (a) shall present information re-
18	quired under paragraph (1) on a country-by-country
19	basis and by combatant command.
20	(c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)
21	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may contain
22	a classified annex. The unclassified portion of the report
23	shall also be made available on an appropriate publically-
24	available Internet website of the Department of Defense.

1	(d) Definition.—In this section, the term "security
2	assistance related programs' means programs and activi-
3	ties of the Department of Defense for one or more of the
4	following:
5	(1) To engage with foreign partners to help
6	shape their policies and actions in the security sec-
7	tor.
8	(2) To assist foreign partners in building and
9	sustaining the capacity and effectiveness of their
10	military and other security institutions to provide se-
11	curity, safety, and justice for their people.
12	(3) To enable foreign partners to contribute to
13	efforts that address common security challenges.
14	(e) Waiver.—
15	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
16	may waive the applicability of subsection (a) to any
17	security assistance related program if the informa-
18	tion required by subsection (b) with respect to such
19	program is submitted to the congressional defense
20	committees under another provision of law.
21	(2) Notice.—The Secretary of Defense shall
22	include in the report required under subsection (a)
23	a list of the programs, if any, covered by a waiver
24	under paragraph (1) during the preceding year. The
25	list shall set forth each program covered by the

- 2 mation on such program is submitted to the congres-
- 3 sional defense committees.
