

**AMENDMENT TO THE
SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1
OFFERED BY MR. COSTA OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of subtitle D of title VII, add the following:

SEC. ____ . PRESERVATION OF 12-MONTH CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN.

(a) (a) In General.—Notwithstanding the amendments made by section 71107, a State that, on or after the date of enactment of this Act, elects 12-month continuous eligibility for individuals under 19 years of age pursuant to section 1902(e)(12) of the Social Security Act shall be deemed to satisfy the redetermination frequency requirement added by section 1902(e)(14)(L) of such Act, as amended by section 71107(a) of this Act, with respect to such individuals.

(b) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect the application of section 1902(e)(14)(L) of the Social Security Act to any individual who is not described in subsection (a).
