Page 10, insert after line 26 the following:

1 REPORT ON HOME-TO-WORK VEHICLES FOR
2 CONTAINMENT EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM
3 SEC. 105. (a) REPORT.—The Chief of the United
4 States Capitol Police shall submit a report (in the appro-
5 priate format) to the Committee on House Administration
6 of the House of Representatives, the Committee on Rules
7 and Administration of the Senate, and the Committees on
8 Appropriations of the House of Representatives and Sen-
9 ate not later than 60 days after enactment of this Act
10 to assess the viability of providing home-to-work vehicles
11 for members of the Containment Emergency Response
12 Team (CERT) for the purpose of recall.

13 (b) REQUIREMENTS OF REPORT.—The report sub-
14 mitted under subsection (a) shall include an assessment
15 of each of the following:

- 16 (1) Individual vehicle costs.
17 (2) Requirements to secure specialized equip-
18 ment and related costs to meet those requirements.
19 (3) Other costs associated with such vehicles.

1 (4) The effect of home-to-work vehicles on the
2 ability to conduct the expeditious recall of members
3 of the CERT.

4 (5) Common practices and lessons learned in
5 the recall of other similar specialized law enforce-
6 ment units, both with and without home-to-work ve-
7 hicles.

8 (6) The recommendation of the Capitol Police
9 in obtaining and providing such vehicles to members
10 of the CERT.

11 (c) CLASSIFICATION OF REPORT.—The report under
12 this section shall be submitted in unclassified form but
13 may be accompanied by a classified annex.
